George Fox University committed to respecting intellectual property rights and expects all members of the university community to do the same. To safeguard the rights of creators, the university has established the following trademark and copyright policy.

# 1. Use of University Trademarks

- a. University trademarks are the exclusive property of the university.
- b. Proper authorization is required for the use of university trademarks.
- c. Unauthorized use may result in legal action.

# 2. Use of Copyrighted Material

- a. Respect copyright laws when using, reproducing, or distributing copyrighted material.
- b. Obtain proper permissions or licenses for copyrighted material use.

#### 3. Prohibited Activities

- a. Unauthorized Use: Any unauthorized use of trademarks, logos, or copyrighted material belonging to the university, its affiliates, or third parties is strictly prohibited.
- b. Reproduction and Distribution: Reproducing, distributing, or displaying copyrighted material without proper authorization is not alked

- a. The university will vigorously defend against any claims of trademark or copyright infringement.
- b. Legal action may be taken to protect the university's intellectual property rights.
